**SUBJECT:** Supplement to Advice 1529-E Regarding Replacement of  
Schedule PX - Power Exchange Energy with Schedule PE –  
Procured Energy and Establishment of the Procured Energy  
Charge and Procured Energy Credit

**PURPOSE**

This advice filing supplements, in part, Southern California Edison Company's (SCE) Advice 1529-E which was filed to withdraw Schedule PX, Power Exchange Energy and establish and replace it with Schedule PE, Procured Energy. This supplemental filing requests California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) authorization to modify SCE's customer Bill Formats where the Procured Energy Charge information is provided.

**BACKGROUND**

On April 5, 2001, SCE filed Advice 1529-E which proposed to withdraw Schedule PX, Power Exchange Energy and establish and replace it with Schedule PE, Procured Energy. Further, Advice 1529-E: (1) modified the Procured Energy Cost calculation on an interim basis to reflect SCE's termination of energy procurement from the PX and the current state of the power market; (2) revised tariffs to change all relevant references from PX to PE and (3) suspended Schedules RTP-3 and RTP-3-GS.

Schedule PX was originally authorized pursuant to Commission Decision 97-08-056 which was issued in the Unbundling/Ratesetting Proceeding (A.96-12-019). The Bill Formats showing rates, charges, and other components on customers' bills were

submitted to the Commission in SCE's Advice 1245-E, and approved effective January 1, 1998.

In this supplemental filing, SCE requests Commission authority to modify the information on the customers' bills to include the Procured Energy Charge information consistent with the tariff changes proposed in Advice 1529-E. The proposed changes to the Bill Formats are contained herein as Attachment A.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge for bundled service customers, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

In compliance with the FERC Order, the tariff changes described in Advice 1529-E filing are requested to be effective on January 19, 2001. Therefore, SCE requests that this advice filing become effective on that same date.
